

CHECKLIST FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF LOST/STOLEN/DAMAGED PASSPORT – MINOR (UNDER AGE 16)

1. Completed Belize passport application form (persons under 16 years)
2. 2 passport-size pictures: One (1) bearing the following certification on back: “I certify that this is a true likeness of [Name of Applicant]” and signed and stamped by the same recommender who completes Form 4A.
3. Declaration of Applicant (Form 4A) which must be signed and stamped by a Justice of the Peace, Notary Public(USA/ROC), Solicitor (UK, Middle East) Minister of Religion or Medical Practitioner
4. Declaration of Applicant (Form 4B) must be completed as above by the parent or legal guardian.
5. Copy of an official ID for the parent
6. Copy of legal document granting custody, adoption or guardianship.
7. Consular Officer at the MRPS will conduct an interview with the applicant
8. Declaration (Form 5) to be completed by parent on behalf of child, signed by a Notary Public (USA/ROC), Solicitor (UK/Middle East).
9. Declaration of Lost or Stolen passport (Form 6) with certification from Notary Public(USA/ROC) Solicitor (UK/Middle East)
10. Two (2) Notarized Affidavits/Declarations: One (1) by Applicant stating particulars of loss or damage, One (1) by parent or legal guardian of the Applicant who has knowledge of the loss of the Passport
11. Police report about loss of passport, or damaged passport (as appropriate).
12. Other form of official photo identification.
13. Applicant must present original Birth Certificate or original Nationality Certificate (as appropriate).
14. Original Marriage Certificate or Divorcee Decree (as appropriate) or Deed Poll registered in Belize if name change is being requested.
15. Fee Money Order \$185.00 made payable to the “Mission of Belize”.

CHECKLIST FOR FIRST TIME APPLICANT FOR BELIZE PASSPORT BY NATURALIZATION – ADULT (16 YEARS AND OVER)

1. Completed Belize passport application form (persons 16 years and over).
2. 2 passport-size pictures: One (1) bearing the following certification on back: “I certify that this is a true likeness of [Name of Applicant]” and signed and stamped by the same recommender who completes Form 3A.
3. Completed Recommender Form (Form 3A) signed and stamped by Justice of the Peace, Minister of Religion, Medical Practitioner, Notary Public or Attorney at Law.
4. Declaration of Applicant (Form 5) to be signed by Applicant and notarized.
5. Applicant must present Belize passport.
6. Applicant must present original Birth Certificate or original Nationality Certificate, (as appropriate).
7. Original Marriage Certificate or Divorcee Decree (as appropriate) or Deed Poll registered in Belize if name change is being requested.
8. Money Order \$110.00 made payable to the “Mission of Belize”.

CHECKLIST FOR FIRST TIME APPLICANT FOR BELIZE PASSPORT BY NATURALIZATION – MINOR (UNDER AGE 16)

1. Completed Belize passport application form (persons under 16 years).
2. 2 passport-size pictures: One (1) bearing the following certification on back: “I certify that this is a true likeness of [Name of Applicant]” and signed and stamped by the same recommender who completes Form 4A.
3. Declaration of Applicant (Form 4A) which must be signed by a Justice of the Peace, Notary Public(USA/ROC), Solicitor (UK, Middle East) Minister of Religion or Medical Practitioner.
4. Declaration of Applicant (Form 4B) must be completed as above by the parent or legal guardian.
5. A copy of an official Belizean ID for the parent.
6. A Copy of legal document granting custody, adoption or guardianship.
7. Applicant must present original Nationality Certificate.
8. Applicant must present original Deed Poll registered in Belize if name change is being requested.
9. Money Order \$110.00 made payable to the “Mission of Belize”.
